CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. D. Gregory, Auto Court Owner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, windmill, tank, pump and pipe line for Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 18 N., R. 45 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Sec. 20 bears N. 61° 20' W., 960 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: W. D. Gregory
Post-office address: Austin, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0028 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 23, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well 75 feet deep cased with 6 inch casing and equipped with a 1/2 H.P. electric pump jack and a windmill. Water is conveyed to a 2,500 gallon storage tank located at the well; thence by 250 feet of 3 inch pipe, 150 feet of 3/4 inch pipe and 200 feet of 1/2 inch pipe to the home and business site. The place of use is within the E 1/2 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 and W 1/2 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 20, T. 18 N., R. 45 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
