CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes, Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Coyote Hole Spring through dam, pipe and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 8 N., R. 42 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Sec. 15, T. 8 N., R. 42 E., bears S. 19° 17' W., 9,265 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Pete Bertolino

Post-office address: Manhattan, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.002 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 cattle September 1 to December 31 and

Period of use, from January 1 to June 1 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: March 31, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is impounded by means of a small dam; thence conveyed by fifty feet of 2 inch pipeline into a 12 foot by 3 foot half round watering trough. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
