CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Joe Echegaray, Stock Raiser has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Long Valley Well No. 2) through well, pump and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 32 T. 21 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 32 bears S. 88° 45' E., 4,690 feet

situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation; together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Joe Echegaray

Post-office address: % John E. Robbins, Elko, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.028 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 4500 sheep

Period of use, from: March 1 to April 30 and October 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: November 5, 1930

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a dug well 75 to 80 feet deep and 5 feet in diameter, partly timbered and equipped with a gasoline driven pump.

The water is conveyed into a series of galvanized iron troughs approximately 100 feet in length. The place of use is at the troughs in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
