CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Warren O. Wagner, Engineer & Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from School Spring

through riser, pipeline, ditch and pond for Stockwatering and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 17 S., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 35 bears S. 30° 30' E., 1,200 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Warren O. Wagner and Rose Marie Wagner

Post-office address 738 E. Walnut St., Pasadena 4, California

Amount of appropriation 0.002 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 40 cattle and 20 horses

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 3, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a riser placed in the spring; thence conveyed about 40 feet to a pond about 20 feet in diameter by means of a ditch. A 3/4 inch pipeline conveys the water from the riser to the house, which is about 150 feet distant, for domestic use. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
