CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, M. T. Magnuson, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Steptoe Slough through dam and ditches for Irrigation purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 20 N., R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 36, T. 21 N., R. 63 E., M.D.M. bears N. 30° 08' W., 2,320 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Magnuson Ranch
Post-office address: McGill, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 6.0 c.f.s. or not to exceed a yearly duty of 1644 acre-feet from all sources
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 26, 1949

Table with 2 columns: Description of land to which water is appurtenant and Acres. Rows include Lot 1 of Sec. 19, Lot 2 of Sec. 30, and various sections of Sec. 25 and Sec. 36.

NOTE: This certificate is issued subject to that certain agreement dated March 3, 1950 between the permittees under Permits Nos. 12925 through 12931, which pertains to the pooling of their water rights.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
