CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Julian Goicoechea, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cracker Johnson Spring No. 2 through reservoir, pipeline, tank and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 32, T. 25 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 17, T. 24 N., R. 57 E., M.D.M. bears S. 0° 23' 30" W., 20.445 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Pete and Julian Goicoechea
Post-office address: Ely, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.02 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 250 cattle and 2,000 sheep
Period of use, from: April 1 to December 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 31, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of enlarging the spring area into a reservoir approximately 75 feet in diameter and 4 feet deep; thence conveyed by means of 150 feet of 2 inch pipeline to a 600 gallon metal tank; thence by pipeline to 50 feet of 24 inch troughs. The place of use is at the troughs in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
