

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, F. D. Shuck has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Spencer's Hot Springs through pipeline for Bathing and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 Sec. 13, T. 17 N., R. 45 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 13, bears S. 26° 00' E., 55 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: F. D. Shuck
Post-office address: Austin, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.03 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 21, 1952

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is conveyed from the spring by a 1 1/2 inch main pipeline 183 feet long; thence conveyed by three 3/4 inch branch pipe lines to two houses, a shower bath, a wash room and to three wooden bath tubs 30 inches wide, 105 inches long and 24 inches deep. The bath tubs are sunk in the ground and drained below. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
