CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L. F. Maggini, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Walter's Canyon through dams and ditches for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 22 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of Sec. 34, T. 23 N., R. 54 E., M.D.M. bears N. 22° 03' W., 1,712 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator. Louis F. Maggini
Post-office address Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.005 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 cattle
Period of use, from May 1 to September 30 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 28, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is stored in two dams. Dam No. 1 is 100 feet long, 8 feet wide and 8 feet high and impounds the waters of Walter's Canyon conveyed to it by Maggini Ditch. Dam No. 2 is of the same proportions as Dam No. 1 and impounds waters in the main channel of Walter's Canyon. The places of use are at the reservoirs situated in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 and SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 34, T. 23 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
