CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Sheldon Lamb, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Evergreen Channel

through reservoir for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 10 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Buck Horn Cattle Company

Post-office address Alamo, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 5.0 acre-feet per annum

Period of use, from March 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation March 18, 1940

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a reservoir approximately 300 feet in diameter by 10 feet deep. The place of use is within the same sub-division as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
