CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L. L. Larrabee, Broker has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump, pipeline and tanks for Milling

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 23, T. 8 N., R. 32 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 23 bears N. 36° 38' W., 1,190 feet situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Dow Metals, Inc.
Post-office address: P. O. Box 241-3, Hawthorne, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.46 c.f.s. or not to exceed 48,000 gallons per day
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 3, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well 100 feet deep cased with 8 inch casing and equipped with an electrically driven pump; thence conveyed by a 3 inch pipeline 1,400 feet long to storage tanks; thence conveyed by pipeline to the mill and residences. The place of use is within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 22, T. 8 N., R. 32 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
