CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Yomba Shoshone Tribe has presented to the State Engineer

of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

an underground source

through well, pump, pipeline and trough for

stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 10 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 21 bears N. 58° 27' E., 3,405.0 feet

situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Yomba Shoshone Tribe

Post-office address Stewart Indian Agency, Carson City, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.013 c.f.s. or sufficient water to water 500

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 head of cattle of each year

Date of priority of appropriation December 1, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well 128 feet deep cased with 6 inch casing and equipped with a pump and gasoline motor; thence conveyed by 25 feet of 2 inch pipe to a stockwatering trough 5 feet long and 3 feet wide. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
