

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank D. Rathbun, Jr. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump, pressure tank & pipeline for Quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 Sec. 19, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 19 bears N. 6° 42' E., 1,382.78 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
 Date of priority of appropriation October 2, 1952

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 100 feet deep cased with 40 feet of 8 inch casing and equipped with a turbine pump powered by a 1 HP electric motor; thence conveyed to a 50 gallon pressure tank; thence distributed to the places of use by means of approximately 60 feet of 3/4 inch iron pipe. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
