

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS R. D. Stetson, Division Manager has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump and pipeline for Quasi-municipal and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 9 bears S. 14° 27' W., 3,054 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Shell Oil Company
Post-office address: 1008 W. 6th Street, Los Angeles 17, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.0025 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 1, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well 250 feet deep, cased with 60 feet of 8 inch and 190 feet of 6 inch casing; thence conveyed by pipeline to the service station where it is used for drinking water, rest rooms and general service station purposes. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
