CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. Marney has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground

through well, pump, tank and pipeline for Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 17, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 17 bears N. 64° 31' W., 907.4 feet

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: A. Marney

Post-office address: P. O. Box 1542, Las Vegas, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s. or not to exceed 12 acre-feet per season

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: August 12, 1946

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

2.0 acres in the N 1/2 NW 1/4 of Sec. 17, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M. Water is developed by means of a drilled well 620 feet deep, cased with 60 feet of 8 inch casing and equipped with a 1 H.P. Jet pump and a 5,000 gallon storage tank; thence conveyed to the places of use through 750 feet of 3 inch and 500 feet of 3/4 inch pipeline.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
