CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Karl F. Weikel has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Six Mile Well) and troughs through well, windmill, reservoir, pipeline for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows Within the NW 1/4 Sec. 7, T. 29 S., R. 63 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 7 bears N. 26° 58' E., 4,040.2 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Karl F. Weikel
Post-office address: Y K L Ranch, Searchlight, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0156 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 cattle
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 29, 1952

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a well equipped with a windmill; thence conveyed through a 2 inch lead pipe to a masonry reservoir 19 feet wide, 45.75 feet long and 6 feet deep; thence through a 1 1/2 inch pipe-line to a semi-circular galvanized iron water trough 38 inches in diameter and 36 feet 10 inches in length. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
