CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wm. A. Bartholomae, Jr., President has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Segura Well) through well, pump, pipeline, tank and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 7, T. 16 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 7 bears N. 10° 33' E., 660 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Bartholomae Corporation
Post-office address: P. O. Box 111, Fullerton, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.025 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 800 cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 16, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a dug well 40 feet deep, equipped with a windmill tower and head, windmill pump, pump jack and storage tank; thence conveyed from the storage tank to watering troughs. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
