CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wm. A. Bartholomae, Jr. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Upper Davis Spring through dams and ditches for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 Sec. 34, T. 16 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 34 bears S. 31° 57' E., 1,451.56 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72 Chapter 46 Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0156 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 cattle
Period of use, from April 1 to November 30 of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation August 25, 1916

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is impounded in a small reservoir formed by a dam 10 feet long and 3 feet high which is constructed across the main channel about 100 feet northeasterly from the spring; thence conveyed through 20 feet of 2 inch pipeline to a semi-circular galvanized iron trough 15 feet long, 27 inches wide and 12 inches deep; thence conveyed by ditches to a series of catch basins formed by 15 small earthen dams constructed across the main spring channel. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

*NOTE: Permit No. 13485 was issued to change the manner of use under Permit No. 4124 and the date of priority of this certificate, therefore remains the same as that under Permit No. 4124.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
