CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wm. A. Bartholomae, Jr. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Maybe Well) through well, windmill, pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 22, T. 17 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed or at a point from which the NW corner of Sec. 6, T. 17 N., R. 51 E., M.D.M. bears N. 42°10' W., situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada. 23,960 feet

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from April 1 to July 1 and from  
October 1 to December 15 of each year  
\* Date of priority of appropriation October 26, 1929

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed by means of a dug well 120 feet deep which has been re-drilled to 116 feet and cased with 6 5/8 inch casing and equipped with a 12-foot windmill and a Jensen unit type 2-D; thence conveyed through 20 feet of 2 inch pipeline to 80 feet of galvanized troughs. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

\*NOTE: Permit No. 13489 was issued to change the manner of use under Permit No. 9095 and the date of priority of this certificate, therefore, remains the same as that under Permit No. 9095.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
