CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Paul Gemmill, General Superintendent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Caselton Shaft) through mine shaft, pumps, tanks and pipeline for Mining and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 1 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 28 bears N. 5° 31' W., 1,571.2 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 27, 1938

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed in the Caselton Shaft and delivered through a system of pumps, storage tanks and pipelines to the places of use located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 29, T. 1 N., R. 67 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
