CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Collar and Elbow Well) through well, windmill, tank, pipeline and/ troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 36 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 26 bears N. 86° 44' 23" W., 1,618.44 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: The Johnson Ranch
Post-office address: W. H. Settelmeyer, P.O. Box 349, Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.03125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 28, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 70 feet deep, cased with 6-inch casing and equipped with a windmill; thence conveyed to a storage tank 8 feet in diameter and 8 feet high; thence conveyed to two semi-circular metal troughs each 9 feet long, 3 feet wide and 1.5 feet deep. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
