

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Clifford Peacock has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump and ditches for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 19, T. 12 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Sec. 13, T. 12 N., R. 61 E., M.D.M. bears N. 31° 07' W., 12,217 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 2.56 c.f.s., or not to exceed 405.7 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from April 1 to October 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 27, 1949

Table with 2 columns: Description of land to which water is appurtenant; and acreage. Includes entries for 15.25 acres, 11.60 acres, 36.39 acres, 17.55 acres, 20.63 acres, and a total of 101.42 acres.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
