THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Well No. 61) through well, pump and ditches for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 30, T. 20 S., R. 54 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 30 bears S. 51° 26' E., 4,929 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

**NOTE: Permit No. 10999 was issued to change the place of use under Permit No. 10950 and the date of priority of this certificate, therefore, remains the same as that under Permit No. 10950.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
