CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. Howard Gray, Attorney at Law has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through gravel pit, pump, pipeline & ditches for Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 31, T. 18 N., R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 31 bears S. 59° 55' W., 3,970 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Kennecott Copper Corporation
Post-office address: Gray & Horton, P.O. Box 1260, Ely, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 3.0 c.f.s. or not to exceed 564.8 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from April 1 to October 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 21, 1951

Table with 9 columns: Description of land to which water is appurtenant, and 8 columns for acreage breakdown. Total: 141.19 acres total.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
