CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Pharo Arnoldsen has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump and pipeline for Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 34, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 34 bears N. 11° 52' W., 2,532 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Pharo Arnoldsen

Amount of appropriation: 0.02 c.f.s. or not to exceed 10 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 17, 1949

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 2.0 acres in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 34, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. Water is developed by means of a drilled well 460 feet deep cased with 6 inch casing; thence conveyed by pipeline to the places of use.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
