CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert T. Gardner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump, pressure tank, pipeline & ditches for Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 36, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 36 bears S. 70° 19' W., 727 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Robert T. & Lillian R. Gardner
Post-office address: Rt. 1, Box 192, Sunset Rd., Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s. or not to exceed 30 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 26, 1950

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 5.0 acres in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 36, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. Water is developed by means of a drilled well 86 feet deep cased with 8 inch casing and equipped with a 2 1/2 H.P. pump and a 250 gallon pressure tank: thence conveyed through 100 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipeline to the dwellings for domestic use and by ditches to the lands to be irrigated.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
