CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John R. Ross, Attorney-in-Fact has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Willow Canyon Creek through pipeline and ditches for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 29, T. 12 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 29 bears S. 51° 23' E., 5,528 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Grace Marcovich
Post-office address: Wellington, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.40 c.f.s. or not to exceed 19.2 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from March 1 to November 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 14, 1950

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 4.80 acres in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 28, T. 12 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
