CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Dale L. Warburton has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Summit Spring

through pipeline and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 32 N., R. 68 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 15 bears S. 58° 33' 37" E., 1,059.89 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Dale L., Delbert D., Gerald R. & Robert S. Warburton

Post-office address Etna, Via Lucin, Utah

Amount of appropriation 0.005 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 22, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water in the spring is contained by a 50 gallon concrete barrel; thence conveyed through 40 feet of one inch pipeline to a steel watering trough of 1,000 gallon capacity. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
