CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Charles Kielhofer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hot Springs

through swimming pool for Bathing and Medicinal

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 30, T. 1 S., R. 40 E., M. D. B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 30 bears S. 23° 20' W., 1,600 feet

situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 3, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water rises in a swimming pool which is used for bathing and medicinal purposes. The pool is 14 feet long and 12 feet wide and is located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
