CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Roadside Spring

through dam, pipeline and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 1 N., R. 35 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 32, T. 2 N., R. 36 E., bears N. 40° 52' E., 9,060 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Rex B. Clark
Post-office address: Rancho Piocha, Santa Ynez, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.0015 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 250 cattle and 10 horses
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 28, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from the spring by means of a small earth dam; thence conveyed through 20 feet of 2 inch pipeline to a watering trough 12 feet long, 3 feet wide and 30 inches deep. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
