CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mrs. A. C. Florio has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Treasure Well) through well, pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 20 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 19, T. 20 N., R. 50 E., M.D.M. bears S. 77° 11' W., 13,965.52 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: A. C. Florio
Post-office address: Box 39, Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.005 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 cattle
Period of use, from: October 1 to December 31 and from January 1 to April 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 21, 1944

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well 235 feet deep cased with 6 inch casing; thence conveyed through 15 feet of 1 inch pipeline to a trough 20 feet long, 5 feet wide and 2.5 feet deep. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
