

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Norman Hasenyager has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump, ditches and sprinklers for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 42 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Sec. 33 bears N. 2° 30' E., 1,390 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 1.56 c.f.s. or not to exceed 624 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from May 1 to September 30 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 10, 1948

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
