CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Lloyd N. Moore, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Antelope Creek through pond in channel for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows. Within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 46 N., R. 30 E., M., D., B. & M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 corner of said Sec. 28 bears N. 14° 27' E., 2,108 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0312 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1000 cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 11, 1952

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is impounded in a stockwatering pond prepared in the stream bed.
The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
