CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Viola D. Conaway has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Horn Spring through open cut, pipeline, trough & reservoir or Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 19, T. 6 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the U.S.M.M. No. 2 at Delamar bears N. 21° W., 15,840 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator John H. Conaway

Post-office address Caliente, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.002 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 75 cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 1, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a cut into a gravel bank; thence conveyed through 70 feet of 1 inch pipeline to a metal trough 6 feet long, 4 feet wide and 2 feet deep; thence the overflow from the trough is conveyed into a small reservoir. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

NOTE: This certificate is issued subject to the provisions of that certain Ruling of the State Engineer under this application dated October 13, 1950.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
