

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Howard N. Sharp has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Goat Ranch Springs through pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 3 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of Sec. 1, T. 3 N., R. 54 E., M.D.M. bears N. 0° 28' 30" E., 21.710 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Howard N. Sharp
Post-office address: Nyala, via Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.016 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 cattle and 10 horses
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 8, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from the spring by a 3 inch perforated pipe; thence conveyed to three troughs by 4 miles of 1 inch pipeline. The place of use is within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 3 N., R. 54 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
