CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Emil S. Pearson, Acting Regional Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Horse Canyon Spring

through pipeline and troughs for

Wildlife and Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 18, T. 45 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/2 corner of said Sec. 18 bears S. 24° 30' E., 2,654 feet

situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator U. S. of America, Fish & Wildlife Service

Post-office address Swan Island, Portland 18, Oregon

Amount of appropriation 0.003 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 6, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the spring by means of a 2 inch pipeline 200 feet long and conveyed to two troughs each 10 feet long, 38 inches wide and 19 inches deep. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
