CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Nick Yrazabal has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump, tank and pipeline for Domestic purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 17 N., R. 55 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 6 bears N. 39° 50' W., 2,105 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Nick Yrazabal
Post-office address: Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0111 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 3, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well 70 feet deep cased with 6 inch casing and equipped with an electrically driven pump and receiver tank; thence conveyed by 3/4 inch pipeline to the Club and Service Station. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
