CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Deep Creek

through dam and ditches for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 43 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 12 bears N. 27° 29' E., 1,045 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:
