CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Harold Jackson and Katherine Jackson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump, tank and pipeline for Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 20 bears S. 72° 01' W., 1,286 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is apportioned, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.02 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 24, 1947

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well 210 feet deep cased with 154 feet of 10 inch casing and equipped with a 2 H.P. jet pump and a 250 gallon pressure tank; thence conveyed to the stables through 3/4 inch pipeline. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
