CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Snowball Spring No. 5 through pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 14 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 33 bears S. 76° 24' 40" E., 1,026 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: A. G. McBride
Post-office address: W. H. Settelmeyer, P. O. Box 349, Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0075 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1200 sheep
Period of use, from March 1 to December 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 30, 1926

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is conveyed from the spring to a half-round metal trough 2 feet wide and 10 feet long by means of a pipeline. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
