CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Milo W. Smith has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Townsend Well) through well, windmill, pipe and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows Within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 18 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of Sec. 18, T. 18 N., R. 61 E., bears S. 70° 18' 20" E., 11,851 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Milo W. Smith
Post-office address: F. de Millard & Sons, Box 150, Ely, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 400 cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 15, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 32 feet deep cased with 6 inch casing and equipped with a 28 foot tower and 8 foot aermotor windmill; thence conveyed through 4 feet of 6 inch pipe to 20 feet of 30 inch watering troughs. The place of use is within the same sub-division as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
