CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. D. Stewart has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Tunnel Spring No. 1 through pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 17, T. 6 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SW corner of T. 8 S., R. 63 E., bears S. 42° 50' 53" W., 107,965 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statute of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

** Amount of appropriation 0.033 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 cattle and 50 horses

Period of use, from April 1 to September 1 of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation June 30, 1915

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from the spring into approximately 27,000 feet of 3 inch, 2 inch and 1½ inch pipeline; thence conveyed by the pipeline to two tanks. The places of use are at the tanks one of which is in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12 and the other in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 11, T. 6 S., R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

*NOTE: Permit No. 12388 was granted to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use under Permit No. 3475, therefore the date of priority of this certificate remains the same as that under Permit No. 3475.

**This certificate is also issued subject to the provisions of Permit No. 12388 as set forth in the State Engineer's Ruling dated October 13, 1950

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
