CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Pete Etcheverry has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Etcheverry Well No. 2) through well, windmill, pipeline & trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Sec. 10, T. 20 N., R. 48 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Sec. 34, T. 21 N., R. 48 E., bears N. 12° 06' E., 8,300 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada,

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.003 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 80 cattle and 10 horses
Period of use, from September 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 17, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use;
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 85 feet deep cased with 6 inch casing and equipped with a Dempster tower with an 8 foot wheel; thence conveyed to a watering trough 5 feet wide and 15 feet long through a 2 inch pipeline. The place of use is within the same sub-division as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
