CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, O. A. Effinger has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump, tank and pipeline for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 25 bears S. 31° 38' W., 1,394.3 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.022 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 12, 1945

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 1 1/2 acres in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 25, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. Water is developed by means of a drilled well 925 feet deep cased with 8 and 6 inch casing and equipped with a one horsepower jet booster pump and a 120 gallon pressure tank; thence conveyed to the home, horse corral, chicken house, trees and garden through 150 feet of 2 inch, 1,300 feet of 1 1/2 inch and 200 feet of 3/4 and 1/2 inch pipeline.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
