CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Doris French has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Underground tank and pipeline through well, pump, pressure tank, storage/ for Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 21 bears N. 63° 51' 30" E., 2,009 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.02 c.f.s. or 11.16 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 14, 1949

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
1.86 acres in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 300 feet deep cased with 150 feet of 8 inch casing; thence pumped into an 800 gallon pressure tank for irrigation and a 220 gallon storage tank for domestic use; thence conveyed to the places of use through pipeline and hose. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
