

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Herbert Capurro has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Richman Creek (Unnamed Creek) through dam and reservoir for Stockwatering and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 17, T. 26 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 17 bears S. 53° 19' E., 2,590 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of -1937- has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Amount of appropriation -0.0031 cfs., or sufficient to water 100 cattle.
 Period of use, from -January 1 to December 31 of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation November 17, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is impounded in the natural channel of the creek by means of an earth and rock dam 2 feet high and 30 feet long; the stock water directly from the reservoir thus formed. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
