

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, D. E. Hemington, M. D. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pipelines and ditches for Domestic purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Sec. 33 bears N. 59° 58' W., 783.4 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937- has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: David E. Hemington & Florence I. Hemington

Post-office address: 220 E. Charleston, Las Vegas, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.03 cfs.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: September 18, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled artesian well 450 feet deep cased with 200 feet of 8 inch casing and controlled with a 6 inch gate valve; thence conveyed to the places of use through 110 feet of 1 inch copper pipe, 200 feet of 3/4 inch plastic pipe and 400 feet of 3/4 inch plastic hose. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
