CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ted M. Thompson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Five Mile Canyon Well) through well, windmill, pipeline and trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 25 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 21, T. 25 N., R. 54 E., bears S. 12° 42' 40" W., 12,296 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of -1937- has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Ted M. Thompson
Post-office address: Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0125 cfs., or sufficient to water 400 cattle
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 18, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled and cased well 50 feet deep equipped with a windmill; thence conveyed to a concrete stockwatering tank 15 feet square and two feet deep through a 2 inch pipeline. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
