

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Louis Adams has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Muddy River through pump and ditches for Irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 15 S., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Sec. 35 bears N. 26° 34' E., 3,009 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.50 c.f.s. or not to exceed a yearly duty of 173.85 acre-feet

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 15, 1951

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 34.77 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 35, T. 15 S., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
