CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Gwendolen Browne has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe

through pump, pipeline and tank for Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 1, Sec. 10, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., or at a point from which the meander corner of Sections 3 and 10, T. 14 N., R. 18 E. bears N. 4° 03' W., 752 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Gwendolen Browne
Post-office address Minden, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0016 c.f.s. from June 1st to Sept. 15th of each year - 50 gallons per day per capita during non-summer season
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 1, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water pumped from Lake Tahoe by means of a 1 1/2 H.P. pump and through approximately 350 feet of 2 1/2-inch pipe to a 315 gallon pressure tank. Place of use is in Lot 1, Sec. 10, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
