CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Knud Nielson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Rock Creek through dam and ditches for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 30 N., R. 46 E. or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 5 bears N. 35° 17' E., 3,178 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Knud Nielson
Post-office address: Battle Mountain, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 1.8 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 14, 1950

Description of lands to which water is appurtenant: 160 acres in the NW 1/4 Sec. 36, T. 31 N., R. 45 E., M.D.B.&M. The duty of water is limited to 4 acre-feet per acre irrigated.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
